UNITED ARTS AWARDS FIRST ORANGE COUNTY VENUE SUBSIDY GRANTS TO 19 ARTS AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS

ORLANDO – March 10, 2020 – United Arts of Central Florida (United Arts) announced the recipients of its first cycle of Orange County Venue Subsidy Grants. Nineteen organizations were awarded grants totaling \$277,687.

Through a \$500,000 allocation from Orange County Government, United Arts has created a new grant program that will bring more arts and cultural programs to Orange County. This grant will give arts and cultural nonprofits of all sizes the ability to bring programming to Orange County that will appeal to a wide range of audiences by subsidizing the rental costs of venues throughout the County.
