The following 10 reasons show why an investment in artists, creative workers, and arts organizations is vital to the nation's post-pandemic healing and recovery The arts are fundamental to our humanity. They ennoble and inspire us—fostering creativity, empathy, and

- 1. Arts unify communities. 72% of Americans believe "the arts unify our communities regardless of age, race, and ethnicity" and 73% agree that the arts "helps me understand other cultures better"—a perspective observed across all demographic and
- the population believe the arts "lift me up beyond everyday experiences," and 73% feel the arts give them "pure pleasure to experience and participate in." 2. Arts improve individual well-being. 81% of the population says the arts are a "positive experience in a troubled world," 69% of
- nonprofit arts industry alone generates \$264.9 million in economic activity annually—spending by organizations and their arts employment has a positive and causal effect on overall employment. (U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis). Orange County's audiences—which supports 4,943 jobs and generates \$50.3 million in local, state, and federal government revenue. (2022) supports 244,510 jobs (bigger than transportation, education, and agriculture). The arts accelerate economic recovery: a growth in transportation, construction, and agriculture. In Florida, arts and culture is a \$39 billion industry—3.1% of the state economy—and that supports 4.9 million jobs (2021). That is 4.4% of the nation's economy—a larger share of GDP than powerhouse sectors such as 3. Arts strengthen the economy. The nation's arts and culture sector—nonprofit, commercial, education—is a \$1.02 trillion industry
